WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Seniors with an unweighted GPA of 2.5; Juniors with an unweighted GPA of 2.75
- Students with qualifying test scores:
 - ✓ SAT: Math 530, Reading sub-score 26 or Evidence Based Reading & Writing 480
 - ✓ ACT: Math 21, English 21 or
 - ✓ APP (Alternate Placement Program): qualifying grades from certain HS courses
 - ✓ ACCUPLACER qualifying placements
 - ✓ TOEFL qualifying scores
- A combination of scores from different test and dates may be used to meet requirements
- Students who are at least 16 years old and have completed their sophomore year
- Students able to replace two high school electives with one Montgomery College class

WHEN AND WHERE WILL CLASSES BE HELD?

- Classes are held at **USG; MC's Campuses or Online**, taught by **Montgomery College professors**
- Classes will meet 3 times a week, for a double period 2 & 3 @ **USG ONLY**, during TWH's regular school day.

Students have the option of taking other classes on a Montgomery campus, and may substitute one 3-credit college Class for two high school electives.

WHAT IS THE COST?

- The 2018-2019 fees are listed below. A slight increase in fees for 2019-2020 is possible
 - Application fee = (FREE between Oct. 1 – April 15; otherwise \$25.00)
 - 3 credit course fee = \$247.05*
 - MC fees = \$125.00**
 - Estimated textbook cost = \$100.00**

APPROXIMATE TOTAL = \$472.05

*Students who are eligible for financial assistance do not pay course fee

All students may apply for a **MC High School Grant to help cover the cost of MC fees/books

- Students are responsible for obtaining required textbooks and materials

HOW DO I BEGIN THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS?

- Meet with Mr. Oliver to discuss your eligibility and receive a *Dual Enrollment Approval* form
- Discuss your interest in the program and obtain written approval from your parent/guardian
